## Dean Radin, PhD

I was born on February 29th. I will celebrate my 14th birthday in 2008. For my 13th birthday I rented a roller skating rink for an evening, invited all my friends, and we ate hot dogs, cup cakes, and shared a Spiderman-themed birthday cake. That seemed appropriate for a 13 year old. I haven't decided yet what to do for my 14th birthday.

My first career interest, at chronological age 4, was to be "jet propelled." It took many more years before I could better articulate what I meant by that, but that's how I responded when adults asked what I wanted to be when I grew up. My next career interest was the classical violin, which I started at age 5 and continued to play for the next 20 years, the last five as a professional. Then I switched to fiddle and 5-string banjo and played in bluegrass bands for a number of years. Between gigs, I pursued other interests and graduated with a degree in electrical engineering, magna cum laude with senior honors, from the University of Massachusetts (Amherst), a masters in electrical engineering focusing on cybernetics and control systems, from the University of Illinois (Champaign-Urbana), and then a PhD in psychology, also from the University of Illinois. For my dissertation I developed and tested what may have been the first computer-based touch typing training system.

For a decade after my PhD I worked at AT&T Bell Laboratories and later at GTE Laboratories on advanced telecommunications R&D. Projects included designing the human interfaces to telecomm network operations centers in the US and Japan, developing a rapid prototyping system for complex human-computer interface designs (this was before there were personal computers), and studying ways of enhancing brainstorming and creativity in industry. While at Bell Labs, for fun I wrote a series of humorous articles for the science spoof magazine, *Journal of Irreproducible Results*. One of those articles later almost accidentally started World War III in a way that would have appealed to Stanley Kubrick's *Dr. Strangelove*. I'll explain why some other time.

Throughout my formative years and first jobs, I never forgot my original interest to be jet propelled. Ultimately I understood that what I was trying to express as a child was an overriding fascination about the outer limits of inner space -- the depths and capacities of the human mind. As a pre-teen I read everything I could find on mythology, fairy tales, folklore, eastern philosophy, western psychology, and lots of science fiction. Around age 13, as my interests in science and engineering grew, I started to conduct experiments on hypnosis and psychic (or "psi") phenomena. In hindsight, I think these interests were probably encouraged by growing up in an artistic family and bolstered significantly by roughly 10,000 hours of practicing the violin.

While at Bell Labs I started to publish some of my psi experiments. Then I started to attend the annual conferences of the Parapsychological Association and the Society for Scientific Exploration, and to present talks at their annual meetings. I was delighted

at having found groups of scientists who were as interested in these phenomena as I was, and the contacts I made eventually led to my gaining appointments to conduct psi research at Princeton University, University of Edinburgh, University of Nevada, SRI International and Interval Research Corporation. At SRI International I worked on a secret government-funded program of psi research. Much of that program has since been declassified and accounts about it (some more accurate than others) can be found in many books. In 2000 I cofounded the Boundary Institute and since 2001 I've been Senior Scientist at the Institute of Noetic Sciences. I also hold an adjunct appointment in the Psychology Department at Sonoma State University and am on the Distinguished Consulting Faculty at Saybrook Graduate School.

I've now spent the majority of my professional career doing what the 4 year old Dean expressed as being jet propelled -- experimentally probing the far reaches of human consciousness, principally psi phenomena. Very few scientists are actively engaged in research on this perennially interesting topic. This is not because of a lack of interest. I've found that most scientists are very interested in psi phenomena, but science, like any social enterprise, has strictly enforced rules of publicly acceptable beliefs, and so it is not safe for one's scientific career to pursue highly controversial topics (that goes for many controversial topics, not just psi). In addition, funding and controversy in science are inversely proportional, so even iconoclasts who don't care much about what other people think are severely resource limited. Perhaps because of my unusual choice of profession, and the risk that that choice entails, I was featured in a New York Times Magazine article in 1996.

My interest in psi was originally motivated out of a child's intuitive sense that the mind is far more mysterious and powerful than we know. Through education and experience I've also come to appreciate that these experiences are also responsible for most of the greatest inventions, artistic and scientific achievements, creative insights, and religious epiphanies throughout history. Understanding this realm of human experience thus offers more than mere academic interest -- it touches upon the very best that the human intellect and spirit have had to offer. I discovered while working on these topics that I enjoy the challenge of exploring the frontiers of science, and that I am comfortable tolerating the ambiguity of not knowing the "right answer," which is a constant companion at the frontier.

After experimentally studying these phenomena as a scientist for about 30 years, I've concluded (so far) that some psychic abilities are genuine, and as such, there are important aspects of the prevailing scientific worldview that are seriously incomplete. I've also learned that many people who claim to have extremely accurate or unfailingly reliable psychic abilities are delusional or mentally ill. There are also reprehensible con artists who claim to be psychic and charge huge sums for their services. These two classes of so-called psychics are the targets of celebrated prizes offered by magicians for demonstrations of psychic abilities. Those prizes are safe because the claimed abilities of these people either do not exist at all, or they're far weaker than the claimants wish to believe. But the vast majority of the scientific evidence for psi effects, and in particular the evidence that convinced me, is based on the accumulated laboratory performance of people who do not claim to possess special abilities.

There is ample room for scholarly debate about these topics, and I know a number of informed scientists whom I respect who have reached different conclusions. But I've also learned that most of the hostile rants one reads about this topic are pure bluster proclaimed by those who don't know what they're talking about. Their rejections seem to be motivated by fundamentalist beliefs of the scientific or religious kind, rather than by rational, well-reasoned arguments.

# Loyd Auerbach, MS



Loyd Auerbach is well-known to the public as an expert on Ghosts and Psychic Experience. With a Master's degree in Parapsychology, he is Director of the Office of Paranormal Investigations, a Professor at JFK University, and creator and Instructor of the Certificate Program in Parapsychological Studies at HCH Institute, also available for distance learning. He is a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of Forever Family Foundation, and also sits on the Rhine Research Center Advisory Board. He was a Consulting Editor and columnist for FATE magazine from 1991-2004. He is a past President of the California Society for Psychical Study and is past President of the Psychic Entertainers Association where he also currently sits on the Board of Directors.

Auerbach is a professional mentalist and psychic entertainer, performing as Professor Paranormal – a title that follows him into this more serious work.

He has authored seven books on the Paranormal, including *A Paranormal Casebook: Ghost Hunting in the New Millennium* (Atriad Press, 2005), *Hauntings & Poltergeists: A Ghost Hunter's Guide* (Ronin Publishing, 2004) and *Ghost Hunting: How to Investigate the Paranormal* (Ronin, 2004). His most recent is *Haunted by Chocolate: How to Go from Chocoholic to Chocolate Gourmet* (Atriad, fall 2007).

Auerbach has appeared on well over 100 national and local TV shows and other media features including *Larry King Live*, *Oprah*, *Criss Angel: Mindfreak*, *Sightings*, *In Search Of*, the *Today Show*, and *Unsolved Mysteries* as well other spots on A&E, the History Channel, the Travel Channel, the Sci Fi Channel, the Discovery Channel, and The Learning Channel.

# Jim Tucker, MD



Jim B. Tucker, M.D., a board-certified child psychiatrist, conducts research into children's reports of past-life memories at the University of Virginia Division of Perceptual Studies. He worked with Dr. Ian Stevenson, the founder of the research, for several years before taking it over upon Dr. Stevenson's retirement in 2002. He is the author of *Life Before Life: A Scientific Investigation of Children's Memories of Previous Lives*, an overview of cases from forty years of work.

Dr. Tucker attended the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, where he graduated Phi Beta Kappa with a BA degree in psychology in 1982, followed by a Medical Degree four years later. He then received training in general psychiatry and child psychiatry at the University of Virginia. After a stint in private practice, he returned to the University of Virginia and has now published a number of articles in scientific journals.

Dr. Tucker is Assistant Professor of Psychiatry and Neurobehavioral Sciences at the University of Virginia Health System. In addition to conducting research, he serves as medical director of the UVA Child & Family Psychiatry Clinic.



## **Bruce Greyson, MD**

Bruce Greyson, M.D., is the Chester F. Carlson Professor of Psychiatry & Neurobehavioral Sciences and Director of the Division of Perceptual Studies at the University of Virginia. He was a founder and Past President of the International Association for Near-Death Studies, and for the past 26 years has edited the Journal of Near-Death Studies.

Dr. Greyson graduated from Cornell University with a major in psychology in 1968, received his medical degree from the State University of New York Upstate Medical College in 1973, and completed his psychiatric residency at the University of Virginia in 1976. He held faculty appointments in psychiatry at the University of Michigan (1978-1984) and the University of Connecticut (1984-1995), where he was Clinical Chief of Psychiatry, before returning to the University of Virginia, where he has practiced and taught psychiatry and carried out research since 1995.

His research for the past three decades has focused on near-death experiences and has resulted in more than 70 presentations to national scientific conferences, more than 100 publications in academic medical and psychological journals, 3 edited books, and several research grants and awards.

# Robert Brown



Robert Brown is an International medium in the true sense of the word, he has been invited to demonstrate his gifts in many countries including, Germany, Switzerland, India, United Kingdom, New Zealand, Canada and throughout the U.S.A

As an international spokesperson on the topics of death, dying, grief, and afterlife science, Dianne has appeared in documentaries (NBC's "Ancient Prophecies", NBC's "Sci-Fi Investigates", CBC's "Man Alive", The Learning Channel's "Afterlife Series", etc.), as a talk-show panelist (Oprah, Geraldo, Rolanda, Sally, etc.), and in countless televised and radio interviews.

She is the author of *Afterlife Encounters: Ordinary People, Extraordinary Experiences*, as well as *Life After Loss* and many journal articles. Dianne currently conducts survival research through the University of Virginia and independently. She serves as the President for the Forever Family Foundation and staff for the Edgebrook Center.

# Arthur Hastings, PhD

Arthur Hastings is Research Director of the Institute of Transpersonal Psychology and a former faculty Chair for the residential master's and doctoral programs, former Dean and President of the Institute, and a Past President of the Association for Transpersonal Psychology. He holds the rank of Professor, and is Director of the William James Center for Consciousness Studies. His areas of specialization are transpersonal theory, research methods, altered states of consciousness, and parapsychology.

Prior to his arrival at the Institute in 1975, Arthur taught at Stanford University, the University of Nevada, and the University of California at Santa Barbara. He is the author of *With the Tongues of Men and Angels: A Study of Channeling*, co-author of *Argumentation and Advocacy*, *Changing Images of Man*, and senior editor of *Health for the Whole Person*, an award winning book on holistic medicine. He has conducted research on bereavement, creativity, remote viewing and hypnosis.

His recent publications include articles on bereavement, transpersonal theory, scientists' resistance to belief, a diversity bibliography, and hypnosis and non-drug altered states. He is the book review editor for the *Journal of Transpersonal Psychology*.

Hastings and a student team have developed and are currently researching the psychomanteum mirror gazing process for bereavement feelings, creativity, and self awareness. Their study shows significant decreases in grief, sadness and other bereavement as a result of this experiential process. Findings have been published in *Omega*, a professional journal, and presented at scientific conferences. Hastings has received a \$100,000 grant to further the research. Participation in this project is now open to the ITP community and the public.

Arthur has had postdoctoral studies with M.H. Erickson (hypnosis), F.S. Perls (gestalt therapy), and Sogyal Rinpoche and Tarthang Tulku (Buddhism). He is also a semi-professional magician and has been known to do magic at ITP events and celebrations.

# Gary E. Schwartz, PhD



Gary E. Schwartz, Ph.D., is Professor of Psychology, Medicine, Neurology, Psychiatry, and Surgery at the University of Arizona where he is Director of the Laboratory for Advances in Consciousness and Health (formerly the Human Energy Systems Laboratory). He is also Director of Development of Energy Healing at Canyon Ranch Resorts.

He received his Ph.D. in psychology from Harvard University in 1971 and was an assistant professor at Harvard for five years. He later served as a professor of psychology and psychiatry at Yale University, director of the Yale Psychophysiology Center, and co-director of the Yale Behavioral Medicine Clinic, before moving to Arizona in 1988.

He has published more than four hundred and fifty scientific papers, including six papers in the journal *Science*. Gary has also co-edited eleven academic books, is the author of *The Afterlife Experiments* (2002), *The Truth about Medium* (2005), *The G.O.D. Experiments* (2006), and *The Energy Healing Experiments* (2007) and is co-author of *The Living Energy Universe* (1999).

He is a Fellow of the American Psychological Association, the American Psychological Society, the Society for Behavioral Medicine, and the Academy for Behavioral Medicine Research. He received a Young Psychologist Award and an Early Career Award for Distinguished Research from the American Psychological Association. In 2004 he received a Distinguished Scientist Award from the Association for Comprehensive Energy Psychology, and in 2006 a Distinguished Scientist Award from the United States Psychotronic Association.

Gary served as the founding President from 2004-2006 of the Forever Family Foundation.
